Heads Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been really wonderful returning to full activities this term and seeing how well our amazing young people have settled back into school.

Our most exciting news is that our second site on Mayow Road Forest Hill is fully open. On waters Road we are really enjoying having more space and all of our specialist rooms available. Our 36 new year 7 students have settled in well. It is lovely to have students back accessing a busy dining room together. In addition, dance club, music activities, visits from Waffle the therapy dog and trampolining are all fully up and running. A new addition to the week is whole school singing together in the hall. The students and staff all love it! We are enjoying assemblies together and had a wonderful Talent show this week as part of our Black History activities this week.

In addition, last week the dentist saw approximately 70 young people! Of course, our young people behaved so well and this was quite an achievement.

Over on Mayow Road site, the students have settled into the new build and it all feels like home already.

Glade classes are settled well and enjoying their outside space and access to the larger play-ground. We have plans to develop a Glade Sensory room, shelters and gym equipment in the playgrounds. Glade students are gradually starting to explore our new local community with visits to the local park.

Outside the Key Stage 5 playground we are also planning to install an outdoor gym, shelters and picnic tables. Inside we have really lovely specialist rooms such as a beautiful library and IT suite. We are also installing a new interactive room that will provide a stimulating new environment for our Grove students. Students here have also returned to a full timetable which includes visits to Community education classes, enrichment activities and lots of visits to our local community. This includes visits to local shops, cafes, parks and local facilities. Our young people are really developing their independence. We are so proud that we now have 7 of our young people independently travelling to school every day – that is such an amazing achievement.

Thank you to all parents who attended our parent's evenings recently – we love to meet with you and discuss our wonderful young people.


